

- Elevating the care of patients across the Valley View network through the purchase of specialized equipment identified by the expert care teams at Valley View, such as a portable life support system to provide advanced therapy for critically ill patients, a skin-therapy device offering a non-invasive treatment option for skin cancers without scarring, and more.
- Equipping Valley View's world-class care teams with the resources they need to deliver ever-more-responsive, personalized treatment through staff-identified projects that elevate compassionate care, such as FDA-approved devices for new mothers to monitor their newborn's recovery from jaundice at home, funding handmade quilt supplies to keep cancer patients warm while they receive treatment, clothing for vulnerable patients so they can discharge from the hospital with dignity, and more.
- Uplifting employees in need through the Silver Lining Fund, Valley View's employee assistance fund, to provide relief for staff members facing a temporary financial burden. Silver Lining assists staff members facing financial obstacles that impact themselves and their family, from helping keep the lights on to assisting with a month's rent.
- Achieving a Five-Star Rating for Overall Hospital Quality designation for the second year in a row from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), made possible by Valley View's phenomenal employees and community support!
